

Proposed Amendments to the Statute of the British-Slovenian Chamber of Commerce

General Meeting of the British-Slovenian Chamber of Commerce 6 – 13 November 2023



Explanation

The Statute of our Chamber was last changed in 2018, and our legal support has noticed that some of the articles need to be restructured to reflect current developments in the Chamber, the latest changes in Slovene legislation, and to correct inconsistencies in the Statute.

Proposed Amendments – Summary – Part 1

- New naming of membership categories and new criteria for determining the category:
 - Large Companies more than EUR 1 million annual turnover and more than 50 employees;
 - Medium-Sized Companies more than EUR 1 million annual turnover;
 - Small Companies up to and including EUR 1 million annual turnover.
- The amounts of the membership fees for each category shall no longer be fixed in the Statute, but shall be determined by the General Meeting for each calendar year.



Proposed Amendments – Summary – Part 2

- A clearer stipulation of the provision under which one tenth of the voting members of the General Meeting have the possibility to request that the General Meeting be convened.
- A clearer stipulation of the provision under which the term of office of the President and Vice-President is 3 years.
- Fixing the term of office of the Immediate Past-President at 2 years.
- Reducing the maximum number of members of the Supervisory Board from 12 to 11.
