Dear Members,

As we open our **e-General Assembly**, it is a valuable moment to reflect on the year behind us and the progress we achieved together in 2025.

Throughout the year, we remained focused on delivering practical value to our members, strengthening ties between Slovenia and the United Kingdom, and serving as a trusted platform for dialogue, partnership, and opportunity.

**Our Council network** continued to grow, with four active Councils delivering twelve sessions on leadership, artificial intelligence, cybersecurity, human resources, trade policy, and investment opportunities. These meetings provided members with valuable insights and new business connections.

International engagement remained central to our mission. We organised **four business delegations to the United Kingdom**, including visits to London and Oxford, as well as sector-focused programmes in banking and asset management. These initiatives created new partnerships and reinforced the Chamber's role as a bridge between our two markets.

In Slovenia, we continued to deliver **high-quality events** through our Tea with Reason series, conferences, and market-entry webinars. Topics included capital markets, competitiveness, advanced technologies, talent attraction, and the future of energy and infrastructure.

Our membership community continued to grow. **We welcomed new members**, hosted networking events, and maintained close dialogue with businesses across our network. Advocacy also remained an important priority, as we consistently supported a more predictable, competitive, and business-friendly environment in Slovenia.

Through **Chapter Zero Slovenia**, we organised three regional events in Ljubljana, Belgrade, and Tivat, promoting climate governance, resilience, and responsible leadership.

We concluded the year with two standout moments: our business delegation to Oxford and London, and our annual **Christmas Gala in London**, which brought together nearly 150 guests. We also hosted a conference where SPIRIT Slovenia and the Suffolk Chamber of Commerce signed a Memorandum of Understanding.

None of these achievements would have been possible without the trust and support of you, our members, patrons, partners, and friends. In 2025, we were proud to be supported by six Patrons and more than 120 members.
